

Agenda Item 11 – Notice of Motion – Revised Motion (Highcliffe Zig Zag Path)

It is **RECOMMENDED** that: -

1. This Council rescinds Minute 110 of the community Committee held on 9th August 2017;
2. This Council establishes a Task & Finish group to work with officers and residents to re-establish an on gradient link between the Castle grounds and beach using elements of the existing zig zag path:
3. The Task and Finish group will aim to obtain reduced costings by revising AECOM's specifications as well as obtaining a 10, 15 and 20-year solution to be costed by tender;
4. The option of using Gabions and Soil Nailed Posts will also be investigated and costed by tender:
5. The results of all findings will be brought back to Full Council in January 2018 (changed to February 2018 as there is no meeting in January) in conjunction with the outcomes of the Coastal Strategy;
6. The members of the Task & Finish group will be as follows: The two Highcliffe ward members, the chair and vice chair of the Community Committee plus two members from the adjoining ward of Mundeford & Friars Cliff (because of the pedestrian links from Steamer Point and the Coastal Strategy being relevant to both wards);
7. No action to be taken to decommission the existing zig zag path.
